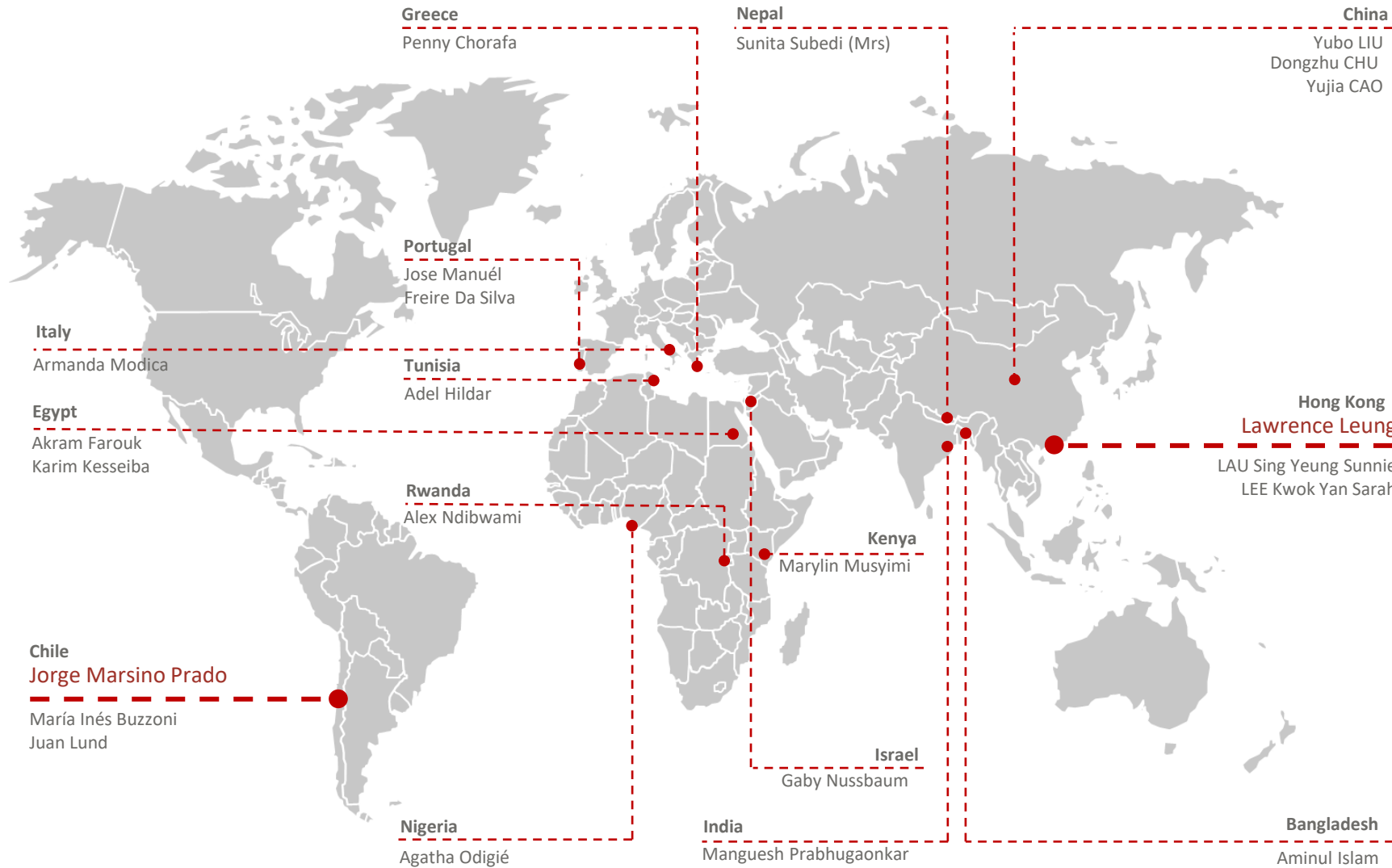

This work will act as a tool for politicians and decision makers to develop improved guidelines and legislation on the subject.

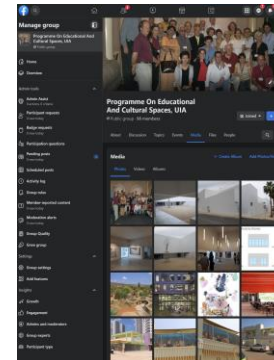
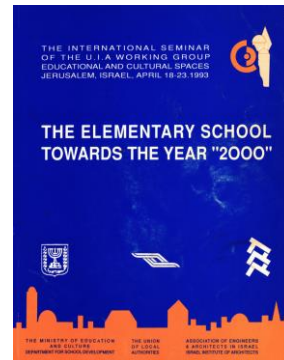

RESEARCH / The Programme Works in collaboration with a diverse selection of practitioners in educational and cultural spaces .

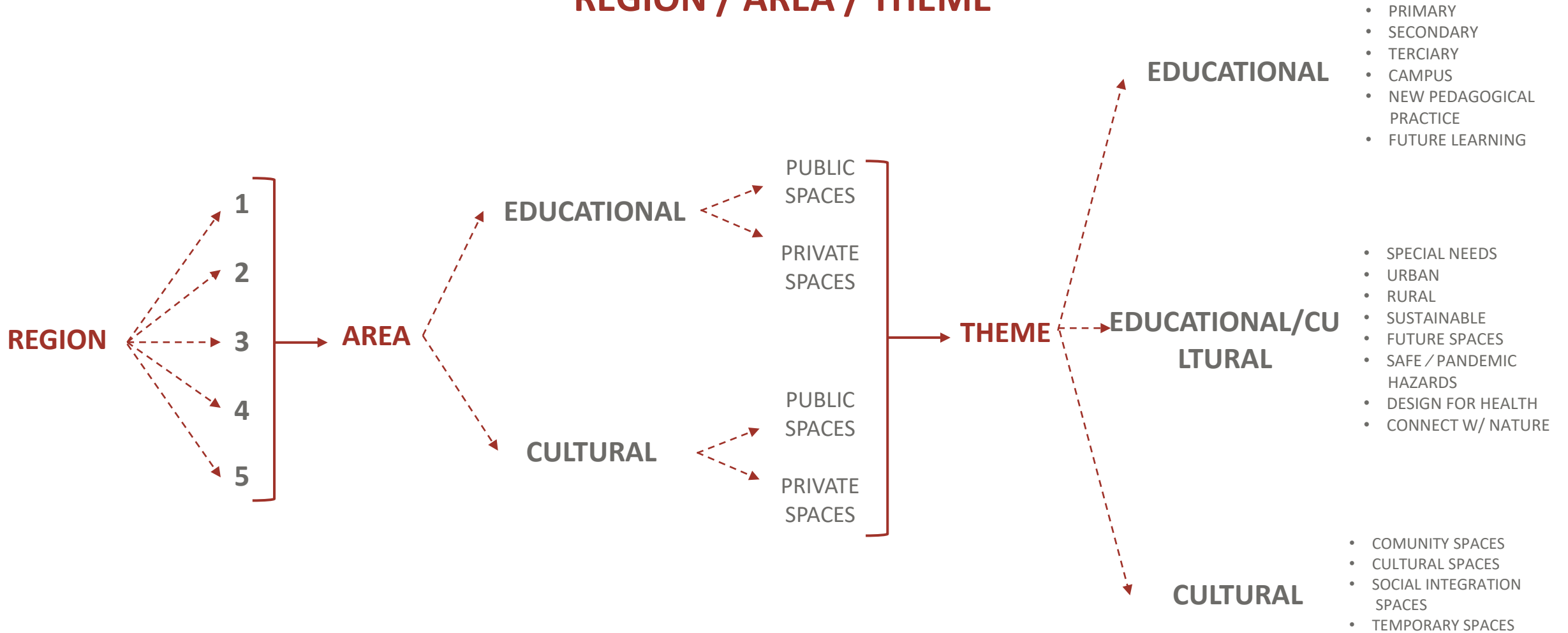
KNOWLEDGE SHARING / The Programme engages with the most recent work of architects designing schools and cultural spaces in various countries, which is discussed during an international forum.

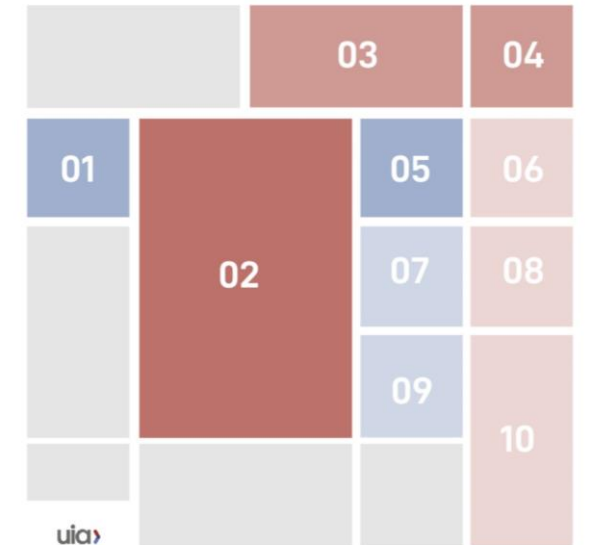

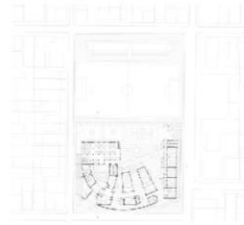

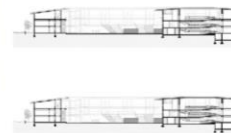
