

This work will act as a tool fot politicians and decision makers to develop improved guidelines and legislation on the subject.


HOW WE DO IT

Architects and urban planners specialized in cultural and educational spaces, cultural institutions, educational experts, international organizations and academic bodies







Being a square format is compatible with formats required in social platforms such an Instagram post or Facebook publication.




OBLIGATORYS AND CHOICES
